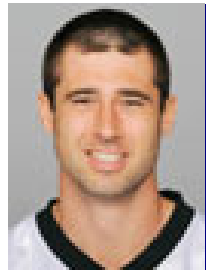

Statistics

- 5.3 million people have a brain injury
- 250,000 people have a spinal cord injury
- More than 50% of all brain and spinal cord injuries are from motor vehicle accidents or falls

Every Day:

- 4700 people sustain a brain injury; 38 will be in a permanent vegetative state
- 142 people die from a brain injury
- 30 people sustain a spinal cord injury
